- Summary of Summer: Tuckerman practice field redone with Bermuda grass. Gym – glass wall covered with new Bulldog and new advertisers – all up! New banners coming in and will be put up soon.
 - New chairs for gym are in with new logo. Will be offering families opportunities to sponsor chair and put name on back of chair.
 - Looking ahead: New coaching hires for 2017-18 – Football, Cheer, Baseball.
 - Last Friday night's game filled all the way up! Great to see such great school spirit.
 - Question on Vandalism: any thoughts on security cameras? They pushed hard on getting cameras. County said no.

More lighting put in on baseball field and in stadium. County did not do what was necessary. Feels it's cheaper to clean up than provide more cameras. Even discussed fake cameras but county said it was a liability. Locking gate is what they have been doing knowing it upsets community but it's one of few options available.
